All that certain lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the northeast side of Cardinal Drive, being shown and designated as Lot No. 38 and one-half of Lot No. 37 of Cardinal Park, plat of Oscar L. Ayers as shown on plat made by R. K. Campbell, July 24, 1941, and recorded in the A. H. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book W, page 27, and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Cardinal Drive, at the corner of Lot No. 39, and running thence with said Cardinal Drive N. 24-54 E. 108 feet to stake; thence N. 68-00 E. 129.5 feet to stake in rear line of Lot No. 12; thence with rear line of Lots Nos. 12 and 11, N. 24-54 E. 100 feet to iron pin at corner of Lot No. 39; and thence with line of Lot No. 39, S. 6-04 W. 121.9 feet to the beginning corner, being a portion of the same conveyed to me by Martha J. Edwards by deed dated February 17, 1941, and recorded in Book 397.

This property is conveyed subject to the following restrictions and conditions: said property to be used for residential purposes only; no residence to cost less than \$5,000.00; no building to be erected nearer than 25 feet to the street on which it faces; no outside toilets permitted and sewage to be disposed of by approved septic tanks; no part of said property to be sold, mortgaged or otherwise disposed of to any person of African descent; property conveyed subject to recorded rights-of-way; no residence to be built on any lot or portion thereof unless said lot has 50 feet or more street frontage.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee(s)'s Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
