to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Basil C. Willingham, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot No. 66, Block F, as shown on a plat of University Heights, as revised, and to be recorded in Plat Book BB at Page 21, and being more particularly described according to said plat as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Corinne Drive, joint corner of lots Nos. 65 and 66, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 56-37 E. 215.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with rear line of lot No. 67, N. 31-18 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 66 and 69; thence with joint line of said lots, S. 56-37 W. 214.1 feet to an iron pin in the East side of Corinne Drive; thence with said Drive, S. 31-13 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is conveyed subject to the following restrictions:

2. No house shall be constructed on said premises at a cost of less than \$10,000.00
3. The lot described above shall not be recut or resubdivided
4. Any construction on this lot shall be set back a total of 50 feet from the front lot line.
