all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Ward 5, Greenville Township,
County, State of South Carolina

Located in Ward 5 of the City of Greenville, on the East Side of
Markley Street, containing 5310 square feet, more or less, and having
the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on corner of Mrs. M. J. Richardson's lot
and running thence along the East side of Markley Street N. 18 1/2 E.
59 feet; thence S. 70 E. 90 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 18 1/2 W. 59
