Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, THEODORE ALLEN BATES

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of TWO THOUSAND AND NO/100 - - - - - (\$2,000.00) - - DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JAMES R. BATES, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All my right, title and interest, the same being a one-half undivided interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the western side of Manly Street, being shown and designated as Lot No. 4, Block 3, Sheet A1, of the City Block Book, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the western side of Manly Street, at the corner of property now or formerly of John Moore, which stake is 138 feet, more or less, from the western corner of the intersection of Manly Street and Elford Street, and running thence along the western side of Manly Street in a southeasterly direction, 46 feet, more or less, to a stake at the corner of a lot now or formerly owned by Emma Burden; thence along the line of that lot, in a south-westerly direction, 133 feet, more or less, to a stake; thence along the back line, in a northwesterly direction, 46 1/2 feet, more or less, to a stake at the rear corner of the Moore lot above mentioned; thence along the line of that lot in a northeasterly direction, 129 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner on Manly Street; and being the same property conveyed to Lidie Bates by C.H. Crosskeys, by deed dated September 1, 1919, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 66, at Page 519, and being the same property devised to Theodore Allen Bates and James R. Bates by Lidie Bates under her will which is on file in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S. C.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
