Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, G. Dewey Oxner, in consideration of the sum of --Six Hundred Seventy-five and 00/100 (\$675.00)-- DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lilla Miller Byrum, her heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot Twenty-nine (29) on plat of Carver Park made by Piedmont Engineering Service, October, 1951, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "AA", page 187, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Waston Street (now Elder Street), joint front corner of Lots 29 and 30, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 30 N. 47-0 W. 122.7 feet to an iron pin on rear line of Lot No. 43; thence along the rear line of Lots 43 and 44 N. 43-0 E. 60 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 28; thence along the line of Lot No. 28 S. 47-0 E. 122.7 feet to an iron pin on Waston Street (now Elder Street); thence along said street S. 43-0 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

The lot above described is conveyed subject to the covenants and restrictions recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 444, page 498, which are made a part hereof as fully as if set out herein, and to the public utility easement granted to the Duke Power Company, which is recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Deed Book 445, page 235. It is understood and agreed that Lot No. Twenty-one (21) of Carver Park, or any part thereof, may be used for street purposes, so as to Permit Waston Street, now Elder Street, to be extended across Lot No. 21.

Taxes for the current year are to be paid by the grantee. The lot herein conveyed constitutes a portion of the property conveyed to me by R. M. Caine, by deed dated March 10, 1951, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 430, page 372.

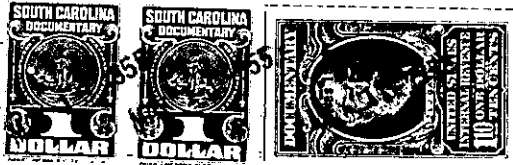
