POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, J. O. Waddell, Simpsonville, South Carolina, have constituted, made and appointed, and by these presents do constitute, make and appoint my daughter, Mrs. Alva W. White, Greenville, South Carolina, my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name and stead, to use, to ask, demand, sue for, levy, recover and receive all such sum and sums of money, debts, rents, goods, wares, dues, accounts, and other demands whatsoever, which are or shall be due, owing or payable to me or detained from me in any manner or ways or means whatsoever.

I give and grant unto my said attorney, by these presents, full power, strength and authority, to have, use and take all lawful ways and means in my name for the recovery thereof; and upon the receipt of any such debts, dues, or sums of money aforesaid, acquittances or other sufficient discharges for me and in my name to make, seal and deliver all things necessary in connection with my business. My attorney, Mrs. Alva C. White, is authorized and empowered to endorse all checks, notes, drafts or bills of exchange which may require my endorsement for deposit as cash or for collection. She is likewise authorized and empowered to draw checks against my account in any bank where I may have an account and to do any and all things connected with my account which I myself might or could do in relation to said account or accounts.

And I further empower and authorize my said attorney to expend any monies belonging to me for my use and benefit to the end that my support, maintenance and care may be paid for out of my own money and in the discretion of my said attorney. My attorney shall be the sole judge of the necessity for the disbursement of my money.
