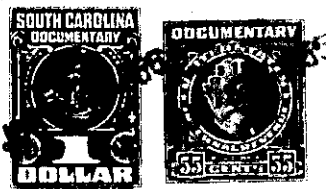

To All Whom These Presents Shall Come:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Virginia G. Knight, et al.

on or about the 5th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-four exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Porter Augustus Criffin

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 18th day of March 1955, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to E. M. Lineberger and E. M. Paul, Jr. for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. G-493)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$488.57

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said E. M. Lineberger and E. M. Paul, Jr. all the right, title and interest of the Defendant, the same being an undivided one-seventh (2/7) interest in and to the following described real estate:

"All that certain lot of land situate in the County and State aforesaid in Ward No. 5 of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated on plat recorded in Plat Book A, Page 403, as Lot No. 8, and fronting 40 feet on the Northeast side of Carpenter Alley, and having a depth of 100 feet.

Also, all that certain lot or parcel of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, in Ward No. 5 of the City of Greenville and known and designated as Lot No. 9 on plat recorded in Plat Book A, Page 403, and having a frontage of 40 feet on the Northeast side of Carpenter Alley, and having a depth of 100 feet.

Also, all that certain lot or parcel of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, in Ward No. 5 of the City of Greenville, and known and designated as Lot No. 13, on plat recorded in Plat Book A, Page 403, and having a frontage of 40 feet on the southwest side of Carpenter Alley, and having a depth of 94 feet.

The property herein conveyed is the same described in Deed from J. W. Gray, Master, to T. M. Griffin, January 11, 1913, and recorded in the R.M. C. Office for Greenville Co. in Deed Book 14, Page 102."
