in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other considerations, in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS

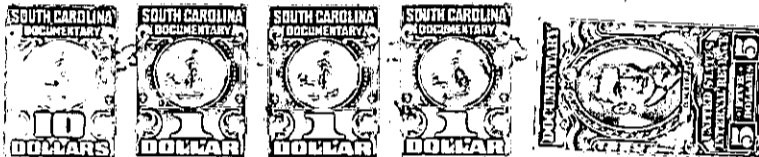

GRAVES, JR., & LUCILE D. GRAVES, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the West side of Scarlett Street (formerly known as Forest Green Road) near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot 218 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August, 1951, revised through June, 1953, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "GG", pages 2 and 3 (also recorded in Plat Book "GG", pages 70 and 71) and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Scarlett Street at joint front corner of Lots 217 and 218 and running thence with the line of Lot 217, S. 83-02 W., 170 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 6-58 W., 75 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 219, N. 83-02 E., 170 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Scarlett Street; thence with the West side of Scarlett Street, S. 6-58 E., 75 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the Grantor herein by deed of L. A. Moseley and John T. Douglas, dated April 9, 1955, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 523, at page 402.
