

1. To pasture to the water line, or to cultivate crops to the high water mark in flood season, to withdraw water for irrigations purposes when the same is available, subject to State laws and regulations.

2. To fish in the waters of the reservoir, subject to the laws of the State and the rules of the S.C. Fish and Game Commission and the rules of the Commission of Public Works.

3. To use boats upon the reservoir, but no motor used in or on boats shall exceed three horsepower.

4. No buildings or construction shall be erected within fifty feet of the high water mark without permission of the Commission of Public Works in writing.

5. The sellers shall have the privilege of removing all wood and timber from the property sold herein within 60 days from the date hereof, provided all stumps are at least 3 feet high from the surface.
