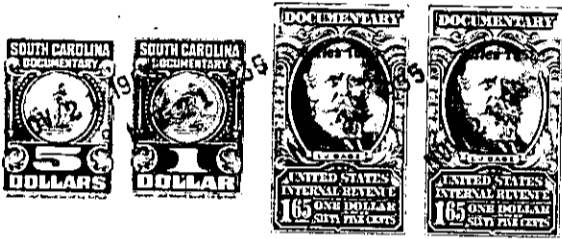
That Margaret Blakely in the State aforesaid,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Blanche P. Vega, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northeast side of Ebaugh Avenue, in the City of Greenville, being shown as the front portion of Lots 115 and 116, of Block J, on plat of East Park, recorded in Plat Book A at Page 383, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the right-of-way of C & W C Railway, and on the northeast side of Ebaugh Avenue, which iron pin is 50 feet from the center of said Railway track, and running thence with Ebaugh Avenue in a northwesterly direction 35 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot 116; thence continuing with Ebaugh Avenue, N. 55 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot 117; thence with line of Lot 117, N. 35 E. 140 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 59-45 E. 50 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot 115; thence across and through Lot 117 in a southeasterly direction and parallel with Ebaugh Avenue, to an iron pin on right-of-way of C & W C Railway; thence in a southwesterly direction with said right-of-way to an iron pin on Ebaugh Avenue, point of beginning.
