and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, upon receipt of \$1392.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said George Young, the following described real estate:

All that certain tract of land situated, lying and being in Green-
ville County, State of South Carolina, and being a part of the land owned
by B. B. Young at the time of his death and containing 13.92 acres, as
shown by a survey and plat made by W. J. Riddle which is of record in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book JJ, page 73 and having
the following courses and distances, as shown by said plat, to wit:

It begins at or near the middle of the Georgia Road on lands now or
formerly belonging to A. Fuller Estate and runs thence along the Georgia
Road S. 85-40 E. 1100 feet to corner on lands now or formerly of E. B,
Martin, Jr.; thence N. 25 E. 650 feet to corner in road; thence due west
by a new line separating the B. B. Young lands a distance of 1154 feet to
iron pin on lands which now or formerly belonged to the A. Fuller Estate;
thence along the line of the Fuller property S. 23-20 W. 550.5 feet to
beginning.
