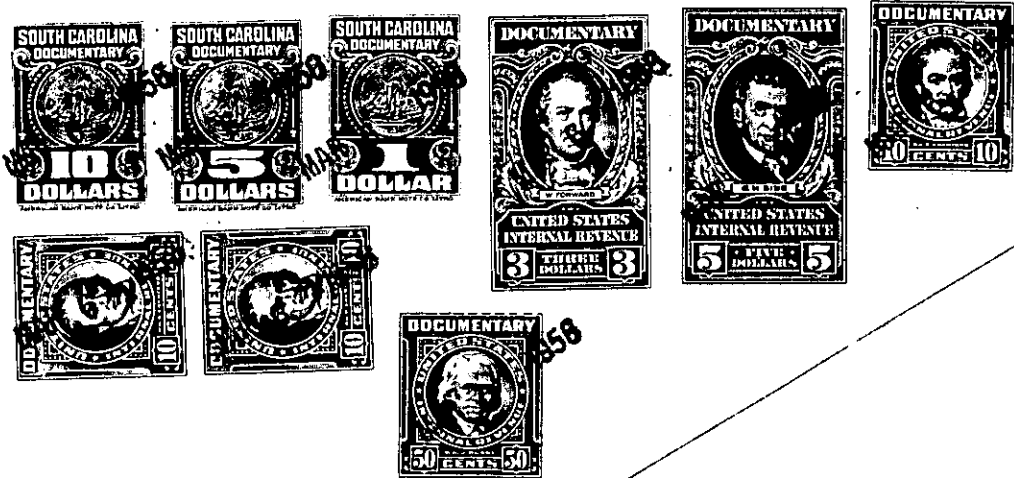

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That <sup>OLIVE FAIRBANKS</sup> NORMAN P. MASON, of Washington, D. C., as Federal Housing Commissioner, by EDWIN G. CALLAHAN, Assistant Federal Housing Commissioner

(hereinafter referred to as "Grantor"), for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release, unto CARL D. FISHER and MARY WILSON FISHER, husband and wife, their heirs and assigns, (hereinafter referred to as "Grantee"): all that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 1, Plat of Parkview, as per plat thereof recorded in the R.M. C. Office for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Plat Book M, Page 49; said lot having a frontage of 65 feet on the Southeasterly side of Alaska Avenue (formerly Morningside Drive), a depth of 150 feet on the Southwest, a depth of 151.7 feet on the Northeast and 43.1 feet across the rear.
