

Know All Men by These Presents:

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Arlie C. Campbell and Maggie Queen Campbell, their heirs and assigns all that piece, parcel, or lot of land lying and being in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a stone, corner of W.P. Morrow, Est and M.C. Campbell land and running thence N 4.20 W 212 feet to a stake near branch; thence along meanders of branch N 18.30 W 155 feet to a stake in said branch; thence N 4.10 W 162 feet to a stake in said branch; thence N 11.40 W 194 feet to stake in said branch; thence N 43.15 E 176 feet to stake near gully, thence along gully N 52.15 E 135 feet to a point in Middle Tiger River; thence down said river S 60.00 E 355 feet to a stake, corner of W. P. Morrow Est, thence S 28.00 W 858 feet to the beginning corner, containing 5.50 Acres more or less.
