That I, J. H. Sentell in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ONE THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED & NO/100. (\$1,900.00)... DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

LIDE L. AND LILA M. RICHBOURG:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Butler Township, being known and designated at Lot Number Two (2), as shown on plat of property of Morningside, as made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in December 1952, which plat is of record in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in "lat book "EE", at pages 2 and 3, reference to which plat is hereby made, said lot of land being described by metes and bounds, as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Spring Valley Road as shown on said plat at the corner common to Lots 2 and 55, and running thence North 43-30 East along the dividing line between Lots 2 and 55, one hundred ninety-three and eight-tenths (193.8) feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot 21; thence South 46-30 East along the dividing line between Lots 2 and 21, one hundred twenty-five (125) feet to a stake at the corner of Lot 3; thence South 43-30 West along the dividing line between Lots 2 and 3, one hundred ninety-one and two-tenths (191.2) feet to an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Spring Valley Road; thence along said Spring Valley Road North 47-45 West one hundred twenty-five (125) feet to the place of beginning.

This property is subject to the restrictions and reservations set out in an instrument of writing dated January 20, 1953, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Deed Book 470 at page 369, reference to which is hereby expressly made as a part of this conveyance, and is subject to the following additional restriction: "All tanks, barrels and containers for fuel oil shall be placed below the surface of the ground or concealed".

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s)' Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s)' Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s)' Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
