To All Whom These Presents Shall Come:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Mrs. Lois T. Davis, et al,

on or about the 17th day of April in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-six exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 27th day of April 1956, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Jack Thomas for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. -----)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Jack Thomas, his heirs and assigns:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the subdivision known as Eastover, near the City of Greenville, and being part of Lot No. 29, as shown on plat of said subdivision, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State, in Plat Book F, page 42, and being the North-western portion of said Lot No. 29, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Maco Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 28 and 29, and running thence with Maco Street, S. 36-10 E. 100 feet to an iron pin in Maco Street; thence S. 54-46 W. 88 feet to a point in the rear line of Lot No. 29; thence N. 25-40 W. 103 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 28; thence with line of Lot No. 28, N. 55-24 E. 69.1 feet to the beginning corner.

BEING the same lot of land conveyed to George D. Davis by deed of James I. Robertson, dated August 15, 1946, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book Vol. 297 at page 281.

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
