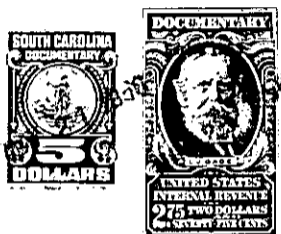
Know All Men by These Presents: ALLIE FARRIS WORTH R. M. C.
