

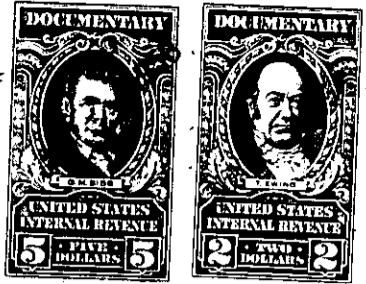

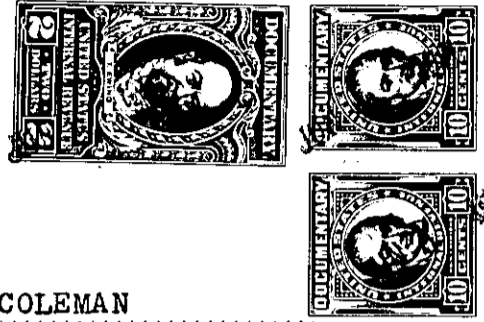

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said G. C. Cloninger, H. J. Duncan, and R. T. Osteen, as Trustees of St. Mark Methodist Church of Greenville, S. C., their successors in office and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the South side of Ethelridge Avenue (sometimes called Ethelridge Drive) near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 3 on plat of property of Ethel Y. Perry Estate, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, November 1, 1945, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "B", at Page 63, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Ethelridge Avenue, at joint front corner of Lots 2 and 3, and running thence with the line of Lot 2, S 5-35 E, 150 feet an iron pin; thence N 78-36 E, 60 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 4, N 5-35 W, 150 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Ethelridge Avenue; thence along the South side of Ethelridge Avenue, S 78-36 W, 60 feet to the beginning corner.
