County, State of South Carolina, containing 9.47 acres, more or less, as will more fully appear by reference to plat made by Hunter Robinson, Registered Engineer, on April 13, 1956, and recorded in Plat Book _____, Page _____ R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and more particularly described according to said plat as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in center of paved county road where branch flows under said road, thence in a southerly direction with branch as the eastern boundary of said tract (offset line commences in center of said paved county road 69.2 feet from nail and bottle top over double culvert, said offset point being west of branch, thence S. 4-53 W. 383.1 feet to point, thence S. 71-23 W. 90.3 feet to point, thence S. 36-59 E. 170 feet to point, thence S. 5-26 W. 290 feet to IP new), thence N. 68-44W. 437.3 feet to IP new 50 feet from railroad tract, thence N. 3-51 E. 1047 feet along the right-of-way of C. & G. R. R. to IP new 28 feet from said track, thence N. 75-37 E. 58.3 feet to IP new, thence in same direction 28 feet to nail and bottle top in paved county road, thence S. 22-11 E. 209.4 feet to nail and bottle top in said road, thence S. 36-25 E. 140 feet to nail and bottle top in said road, thence S. 50-28 E. 138.7 feet to nail and bottle top at point of beginning of offset line, thence in same direction 69.2 feet to nail and bottle top over branch at point of beginning.
