Beginning at a point in center of paved county road where branch fence under said road, thence in a westerly direction with branch as the eastern boundary of said tract (offset line commences in center of said paved county road 63.2 feet from well and bottle top over castle culvert, said offset point being west of branch, thence S. 6-39 . 200.1 feet to point, thence S. 71-33 . 30.9 feet to point, thence S. 80-30 . 170 feet to point, thence S. 8-30 . 200 feet to (W. line), thence S. 02-04 . 427.9 feet to (W. line) 20 feet from railroad track, thence S. 8-31 . 1537 feet along the right-of-way of S. C. R. R. to (W. line) 20 feet from said track, thence S. 71-37 . 200 feet to (W. line), thence in same direction 20 feet to well and bottle top in paved county road, thence S. 02-11 . 200.4 feet to well and bottle top in said road, thence S. 34-03 . 103 feet to well and bottle top in said road, thence S. 23-02 . 122.7 feet to well and bottle top at end of beginning of offset line, thence in same direction 63.2 feet to well and bottle top over branch at point of beginning.
