Highway 291 and running along the center of said county road N. 81-51 E. 240 feet to a point in the center of an old county road; thence turning and running along the center of said old road the following courses and distances: N. 65-44 W. 223 feet; N. 51-59 W. 106.8 feet; N. 51-59 W. 68.9 feet to a point in the center of S. C. Highway 291; thence turning and running along the center of said highway, S. 5-28 E. 329.7 feet to the point of beginning.
