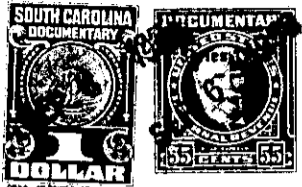

Martha H. Brown and their Heirs and Assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O Neal Township, Greenville  
 County, State of South Carolina lying on the south side of Barton's Chapel  
Road and bounded by lands of Grantor, Mrs Cora Willimon, Ansel Robertson  
and A. P. Brown and containing Three Acres, more or less, and having  
the following Metes and Bounds:

Beginning at the center of road at Robertson's corner and  
 running thence S. 19-18 E. 622.2 feet to iron pin on Willimon's  
 line; thence S. 68-22 E. 100 feet to iron pipe; thence N. 5-00 E.
