CHARTER

EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

NOT 1 9. 34 AM 1956

CORA S. CHRISTOPHER AND MARGARET McCREARY

did on the 29th day of September, 19 56, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is FIFTEEN CO., INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S. C. (P. O. Box 720)

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to purchase, sell and or hold investments of any kind and nature whatsoever. The term investment includes, but is not limited to, real estate, stocks and bonds, personal property, leases, contracts, franchises, patents and business operations or enterprises.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Fifteen Hundred (\$1,500.00)-----Dollars payable in cash

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is fifteen (15) of the par value of One hundred (\$100.00)-----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 28th day of September, 19 56, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Cora S. Christopher, Margaret McCreary, J. B. Rhame, Glenn S. Hollis, Agnes Burriss, Ronald Houck, Ann Sloan, Edna Sizemore, Violet Brazie, Lucy Stradley, Hazel Boland, Mary Elizabeth McCutchen, Harold Gibbes, Douglas Patton, Herbert Lindsay.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, J. B. Rhame ; as Vice-President, Glenn S. Hollis ; as Secretary, Cora S. Christopher ; as Treasurer, Agnes Burriss

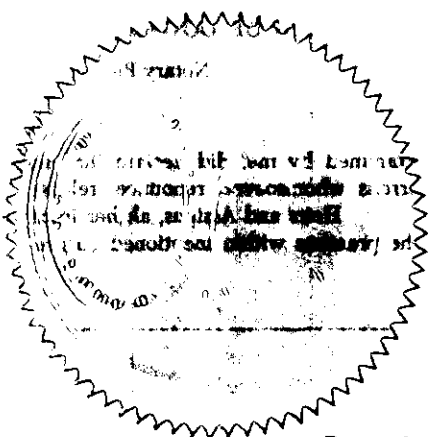
NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville News

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office
