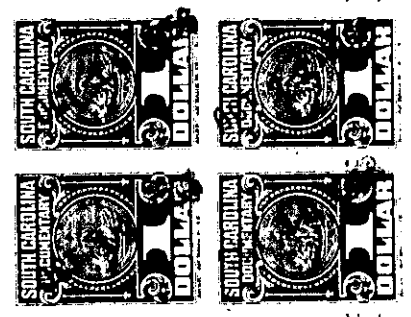

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James I. Jordan, his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, School District 285, near the City of Greer, on the South side of Jones Avenue, containing 10 acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in center of Jones Avenue, corner of Wade H. Taylor, and running thence with the center of said Avenue, N 34-15 E 100 feet to an iron pin in center of said Avenue; thence S 55-45 E 165 feet to an iron pin; thence N 34-15 E 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N 55-45 W 165 feet to an iron pin in center of Jones Avenue; thence continuing with the center of said Avenue, N 34-15 E 469.09 feet to an iron pin, corner (now or formerly) of C.W.
