All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements thereon lying, being and situate in Fairview Township, County of Greenville and being known and designated as Lot No. 9 according to a plat made by Lewis C. Godsey on February 9, 1956 and to be recorded in the R.M. C. Office for Greenville County and being more particularly described according to said plat, to-wit:
