Mrs. Margaret B. Lockett, her heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being on the West side of Westview Avenue near the City of Greenville, being known as Lot No. 22, Section b on plat of subdivision of Parkvale, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K at Page 52 and 53 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit: BEGINNING at a stake on the west side of Westview Avenue 350 feet north of the joint Meyers-Parker line, and running thence along the west side of Westview Avenue N. 4-0 E. 70 feet to a stake; thence N. 89-00 W. 270 feet to a stake on branch; thence along meandering of branch 73 feet, more or less, to a stake; thence S. 89-00 E. 281 feet to a stake on the west side of Westview Avenue, the beginning corner.
