

ALSO all that certain parcel or tract of land, situate in Dunklin Township, County and State aforesaid, containing $104\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, known as Tract No. 2 in the plat of the survey of the lands of Jno. W. McCullough, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone on Cooley Bridge Road, corner of Lot No. 1 and running thence N. $4\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.05 to stone; thence N. $18\frac{1}{2}$ W. 24.75 to stone 3 X Machem's corner; thence N. $13\frac{1}{2}$ W. 22.11 to stone 3xom on branch; thence N. $14\frac{1}{2}$ E. 8.53 to stone 3xom; thence S. $80\frac{1}{2}$ W. 18.00 to stone 3x; thence S. 8 E. 55.38 to stone on road; thence along said Cooley Bridge Road N. 95 E. 20.00 to stone on road at the beginning corner, all of which more fully appears in plat of said tract of land made by Jas. ALSO, Tract No. 3 in the plat of the survey of the lands of Jno. W. McCullough, adjoining the above tract, containing $102\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone on East bank of Beaver Dam Creek, corner of Stokes land, and running thence down said creek as line S. $24\frac{1}{2}$ W. 13.56 to stone on E. bank of said creek where branch flows into it; thence up said branch as a line to spring near big poplar; corner of Tract No. 4; thence S. $4\frac{1}{2}$ E. 42.00 to stake on public road; thence along said road N. 85 E. 16.00 to stone, corner of Tract No. 2; thence N. 8 W. 55.38 to stone; thence S. $80\frac{1}{2}$ W. to stone on E. bank of Beaver Dam Creek, the beginning corner.

BEGINNING at a corner on the West side of the Augusta Road and running thence along said road S. $12\frac{1}{4}$ W. 11.06 angle; S. $10\frac{1}{4}$ W. 8.00 angle; S. $1\frac{1}{2}$ E. 4.87 stake 3x on west side of road, Bounded by J. E. Knight, Jr.; thence N. $77\frac{7}{8}$ W. 18.53 angle; N. $74\frac{5}{8}$ W. 8.15 stake 3xo. On North side of road bounded by B. T. Martian; thence N. $2\frac{9}{10}$ E. 17.98 stake 3xo, bounded by the said Dr. J. P. Knight; thence S. $89\frac{1}{8}$ E. 28.88 to the beginning, bounded by a tract conveyed to Mrs. Kempie Powell.

This being the same property conveyed to J. P. Knight by deed of J. E. Knight on the 26th day of August, 1925 and recorded in Deed Book 117, page 26, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

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ALSO, all that tract of land containing 97.54 acres, more or less, in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, located on the Kirby Public Road, 12 miles from Honea Path, bounded now or formerly, on the North by lands of Austin and McGee; East by lands of McGee and Arnold; South by lands of Arnold and Knight and on the West by lands of Knight and the Estate of Austin, according to plat of survey made by J.
