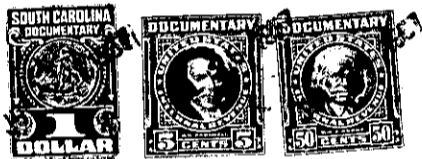
Know All Men by These Presents:

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. J. Hughes, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the South side of Pearl Avenue, being shown as a portion of Lot 7 of Block E on plat of property of Chapin Springs Land Company made by R. E. Dalton, surveyor and recorded in Plat Book 21 at page 41 and having the following metes and bounds:

Begin at a point on the South side of Pearl Avenue 233 feet, more or less, East of Chapin Street and now a distance of 53 feet to the Right of the center line of U.S. Route 29 at survey station 109 39 and running thence N. 21-55 W., 67 feet, more or less, along property this day conveyed to the South Carolina War Department by the grantor to a point; thence N. 2-30 W., 62 feet, more or less, to a point on the South side of Pearl Avenue; thence along Pearl Avenue N. 88.44 E. 32 feet, more or less, to the beginning point. The above described lot of land being triangular in shape and a portion of the lot conveyed to the grantor by J. H. Bruce by deed dated 22 June 1950 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 112 at page 13.
