to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
J. T. Wilson, his heirs and assigns, reserving unto myself a life-estate in the said lands and the use and benefit thereof for my life,

That certain tract or parcel of land, with any improvements thereon, in Butler Township, said County and State, located about seven miles from Greenville, and designated as Tract #5 on plat of the Walter Wilson Estate, prepared by H.S. Brockman, 11-13-51, and delineated thereon as follows:

Beginning at stake in center of public road, joint corner of Tracts 4 and 5, and runs thence with center of said road, N 38-29 W two hundred sixty-five (265) feet to a point in road; thence still therewith N 34-25 W one hundred fifty-eight and seven-tenths (158.7) feet to iron pin, cornering with Frank Jenkins; thence with his line, N 77-20 W five hundred eighteen (518) feet to iron pin, cornering with Frank Cox; thence with Cox line S 6-00 E five hundred thirty-three (533) feet to iron pin, joint rear corner of tracts 4 and 5; thence dividing said tracts, N 84-23 E seven hundred eighteen (718) feet to the beginning corner: Bounded North and Northeast by Frank Jenkins: East and southeast by the said public road; South by tract #4, and West by Frank Cox.

This being a part of the lands owned by Walter Wilson at the time of his death, and conveyed to me by deed of Ernest Wilson, and others, recorded in Book 403 page 403, and by deed of Leslie Wilson dated June 1952.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever, subject to life-estate therein reserved to myself.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, subject to said life-estate.
