(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John T. Laughter, Jeanette Gosnell Laughter and William Glenn Laughter, their heirs and assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and described as follows:

A certain tract or parcel of land situate in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, adjoining the lands of Amanda Gosnell, J. Ed Bridgeman, U. S. Highway #176 and others and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at J. Ed Bridgeman's Southwest corner on the North side of the Spartanburg - Asheville Highway (U. S. Highway #176), said beginning point being the Southeast corner of the certain tract of land conveyed to Belton Gosnell by Amanda Gosnell by deed dated the 26th day of February, 1930, and recorded in Volume 115, page 100, in the Office of P. M. C. for Greenville County, South Carolina, and running thence North 67 deg. 55 min. West 67 feet to a stake on the North side of said highway; thence North 19 deg. 1 min. East 380.6 feet to a stake in the line of the Amanda Gosnell land; thence with the line of the Amanda Gosnell land South 67 deg. 55 min. East 47 feet to a stake in the line of the J. Ed Bridgeman land; thence with the line of the J. Ed Bridgeman land South 16 deg. West 282.1 feet to the BEGINNING, containing 1/2 of an acre, more or less, and being the 1/2 acre tract shown and delineated on a certain plat entitled "Belton Gosnell and Amanda Gosnell Property" as prepared by L. E. Denton, Surveyor, dated October 19, 1957, reference to which is hereby made.
