That I, George F. Townes, As Trustee for James B. Arrowood and in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of TWELVE HUNDRED AND FIFTY AND NO/100 (\$1250.00)----- DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John L. Arrowood, his heirs and assigns:

ALL that lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina known and designated as Lot #46 on Crestmore Drive in a subdivision known as Grand-View, as shown by a plat thereof made by Woodward Engineering Company, March, 1957, and recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book "KK", at page 93, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a pin on the northern side of Crestmore Drive at the joint front corner of Lots #45 and #46 and running thence with the northern side of Crestmore Drive, N. 74-17 E., 60 feet to a pin at the corner of Lot #47; thence with the line of Lot #47, N. 15-43 W., 160 feet to a pin in the subdivision property line; thence with the subdivision property line, S. 74-17 W., 60 feet to a pin at the rear corner of Lot #45; thence with the line of Lot #45, S. 15-43 E., 160 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to me by Arrowood and Burger by deed recorded in Vol. 573 at page 314 and to them by Eliza T. Looper by deed in Vol. 573 at page 311. This lot is subject to restrictions in Vol. 573 at page 415 and Vol. 574 at page 93.
