all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, located about 2 miles northeast of the City
of Greer, lying on the west side of State Highway No. 101, bounded on
the north by lands of Marie Strange, on the east by said highway and
Mrs. Ruth Forrester, on the south by C.C. McGowan, Jr., Edgar Mason
and Bramlett, and on the west by J.D. Dill, containing 60.83 acres,
more or less, and being all of the remainder of the land owned by the
heirs at law and distributees of R.B. Mason, including that certain
tract of land conveyed by Ida Mason and the children of R.B. Mason
to F.J. Bishop, as appears by deed dated June 16, 1956, recorded in
Deed Book 556, at page 155, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
