This indenture by Harper S. Collins, referred to as Grantor and between Greenville County referred to as the Grantee

WITNESS, that the said Grantor has by these presents deeded to the Grantee a farm road on the premises of the Grantor, said road to follow the meanders and contours of the old road and to be fifty (50) feet wide and to run the depth required by Grantor, or to line of the adjoining property. It is understood that Greenville County will construct said road and keep said road in good repair at no cost to the Grantor.

Said road being a farm road and being a part or portion of the land conveyed to Grantor by deed of Mrs. Fannie Hale, being inherited by Mrs. Fannie Hale from her husband, Richard Hale, said deed being of record in the office of the R. M. C. of Greenville County, S. C. in Vol. 254, page 140.

The Grantor desires to invite the attention of the Grantee to notation on the deed of U. S. Trammell to Richard Hale, dated the 21st day of March, 1919, which reads as follows:

"But a cartway fifteen feet wide next to Pollard's land is not included in this reservation and is hereby given and granted." This deed of record in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Vol. 50, page 270.

The Grantor hereby binds himself, his heirs and assigns to warrant and protect this indenture.
