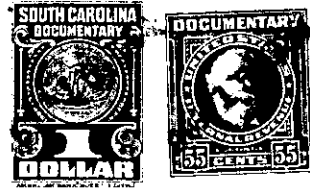

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That I, Caroline E. Mason  
of the County of Greenville,  
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred, and Fifty  
(\$150.00) Dollars  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by Gladys Carter Howard  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Gladys Carter Howard, her  
heirs, and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, situated on the Norther side of Gap Creek  
Road, and being a part of Thirty-four (34) acres formerly owned  
by S. B. Johnson, and being more particularly described as  
as follows:

BEGINNING at a dogwood on the Nothern side of Gap Creek  
Road, where the S. B. Johnson line crosses said Road, and running  
thence N. 49 W. with the common line of the William Johnson  
property, and that of S. B. Johnson (formerly) 328 feet to a  
dogwood on the Notherwestern side of a small branch; thence in  
a Northeasterly direction with the Gladys C. Howard line 204 feet  
to a point in the Gladys C. Howard line; thence in a Southeasterly  
direction, in a stright line 432 feet to the dogwood, point of  
beginning.

The intent of this deed is to convey a portion of land,  
trianglar in shape for the purpose of strightening the line  
of Gladys Carter Howard.

The above described land is a portion the same conveyed to me by  
heirs of S. B. ~~Caroline E. Mason~~ Johnson on the 25th day of  
October, 19 49, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for  
Greenville County, in Book 397 Page 440

said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

Galdys Carter Howard, her
