All those lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lots 12 and 13 on a plat of the property of American Bank and Trust Company, dated February, 1924, recorded in Plat Book F at page 192, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Washington Road, at the front corner of Lot 11, which pin is 500 feet from the intersection of said road with Anderson Road, running thence with line of Lot 11, S. 62-34 W. 212.6 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly of H.
