sum of One Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-seven and 50/100 (\$1,377.50)----- dollars, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto EUGENE RACKLEY

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southern side of Marchant Street near Monaghan Mills in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as Lot No. 7 as shown on a plat entitled "Monaghan Subdivision, Greenville, S. C." made by Piedmont Engineering Service, Greenville; S. C., August 9, 1954, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at pages 86 and 87, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Marchant Street at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 6 S. 25-52 E. 276.4 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 3; thence with the line of Lot No. 3 N. 74-13 E. 53 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence with the line of Lot No. 8 N. 18-13 W. 282.3 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Marchant Street; thence with the Southern side of Marchant Street S. 67-55 W. 90 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to restrictive covenants applicable to Monaghan Subdivision recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 509 at page 443, and to an easement for utilities service dated October 11, 1954, given by J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc., to Duke Power Company and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 510 at page 317.

This conveyance is also made subject to an easement for a high tension power line across the southern part of the above described lot, as shown on the aforementioned plat.



Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee (X) hereinabove named, his successors, heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee (X) hereinabove named, and his successors, heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
