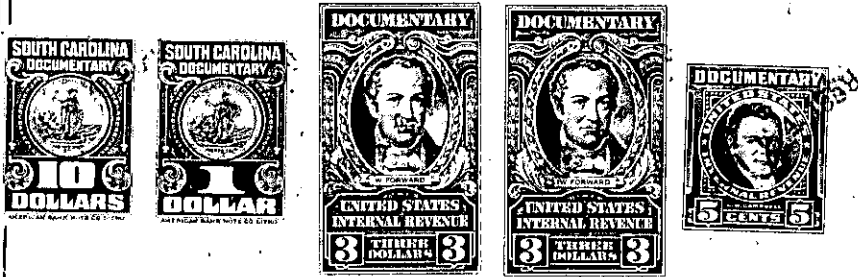

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being property of E. B. Wynn, the same as shown on a plat prepared for J. A. Wyatt, September, 1956 by J. C. Hill and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point approximately 229.6 feet from the intersection of Cedar Lane Road and Parker Road, said point being on the eastern side of Parker Road, thence S. 73 E., 102 feet along the line of property owned by E. B. and F. W. Wynn; thence S. 52-45 E., 117.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 80 W., 175.7 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Parker Road; thence along the eastern side of Parker Road, N. 8 W., 113.6 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to us by Investment Ten, Inc., by deed in Vol. 596, at page 221 in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office.

This property is the separate partnership property of W. W. Willimon and Heyward Willimon and is being conveyed by them to a partnership composed of themselves and R. J. Willimon as the separate partnership property of said new partnership.

This deed represents a capital contribution to said partnership of \$1,926.25 for the land and \$3,468.06 for improvements thereon, making a total of \$5,394.31.
