That We, Paul D. Mackey, Evelyn Mackey Burns and Gladys / Mackey Callaham in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) - - - - - DOLLARS, and other valuable consideration to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. Ranson Mackey, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the western side of White Horse Road, containing 0.95 acre, known and designated as Lot No. 2 of the property of W.E. Mackey, and having, according to a plat thereof prepared by Dalton & Neves, Eng., dated January 1936, the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of White Horse Road, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence S. 61-40 W. 400 feet to a point; thence S. 36-53 E. 105 feet to a point; thence N. 61-40 E. 400 feet to a point on the western side of White Horse Road; thence, along White Horse Road, N. 36-53 W. 105 feet to the point of beginning.

The grantors and the grantee are all sui juris and are all the heirs of W.E. Mackey, whose will is filed in the Probate Court for Greenville County, S.C. in Apt. 419 File 16, and Ethel D. Mackey, a life tenant under said will, who died on June 11, 1959. The property herein conveyed is the same mentioned in Item V of said will.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
