

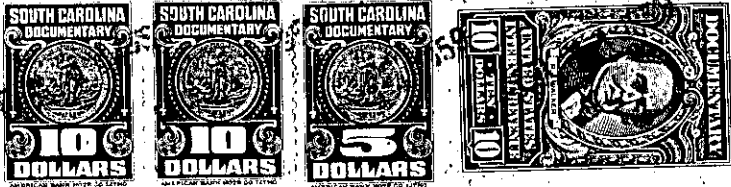
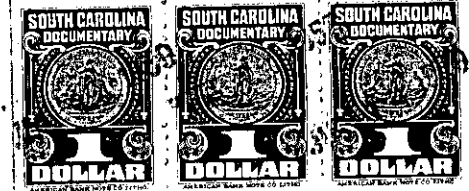

HERSCHEL L. KING and VIOLA I. KING, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, on the East side of Pinefield Drive, being shown as Lot 124 on plat of South Forest Estates, made by Pickell & Piekcll, Engineers, August 29, 1955, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book GG, page 181, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Pinefield Drive, at joint front corner of Lots 123 and 124, and running thence with the line of Lot 123, N. 77-51 E., 143.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 14-45 W., 90.1 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 125, S. 77-51 W., 139 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Pinefield Drive; thence with the East side of Pinefield Drive, S. 12-09 E., 90 feet to the point of beginning.
