LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

I, John Chiles, do hereby appoint my brother, M. Q. Chiles, my true and lawful agent and attorney in fact to act for me and in my name, place and stead, for the following purposes only:

To handle my real estate, to collect my rents from the same, and give receipts therefor, to pay taxes and insurance on the same, to make necessary repairs on same and to do any and all acts necessary to keep said real property in good condition.

To collect payments and interest on loans which I have made, to give receipts therefor, to satisfy mortgages when the same have been paid, to release property from the liens of mortgages which I hold; to make new loans with my money taking as security first mortgages on real estate with the mortgages being made payable to myself.

To deposit and withdraw in my name as attorney in fact any money in any banking institution or any other institution whatsoever; to write checks on any bank account which I may have as my said attorney in fact.

This instrument shall in no way restrict me from conducting business in my own name as I see fit, and may be revoked at any time during my life time by me; and if not revoked during my life time it shall be revoked by my death.
