leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
Harold George, his heirs and assigns, forever,

All that certain piece,  
parcel or lot of land situate and being in Grove Township, State and  
County aforesaid, containing Nine tenths (9/10) of one acre, more or  
less.

Adjoining lands of myself, H. H. Garrison, property of Rehoboth  
Church and possibly others.

Having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning  
at a point in public road at corner of Rehoboth Church property and  
running thence along center of said road South 23 West, 88'- 10";  
thence Westerly 202' to line of Haskell George; thence North 13-30
