Smith in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 (\$1) DOLLARS, and love and affection for my wife the within grantee to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Hazel D. Smith, her heirs and assigns:

All my right, title and interest to all that certain lot of land on the Southern side of Marion Road, being shown as the Eastern half of lot no. 15 on plat of City View Annex, recorded in Plat Book "H" at page 80, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Marion Road, at joint front corner of lots nos. 15 and 14, and running thence with line of lot no. 14, S. 24-50 E. 265.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 60-15 W. 50.02 feet to corner of lot owned by Ralph J Campbell; thence with line of said lot, N. 24-50 W. 270.5 feet to an iron pin on Marion Road; thence with the Southern side of Marion Road, N. 65-10 E. 50 feet to the point of beginning.
