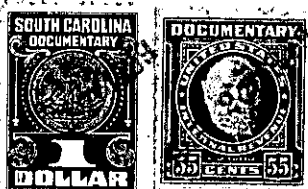

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George Wells Alewine, Sr

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, beginning at an iron pin on the southeast corner of lot number 51 and running thence N 77° 45' E 325 feet to an iron pin on the southeast corner of lot number 56; thence S 12° 15' E 31.8 feet to the center line of Marrow Bone Creek; thence upstream with the center line of said Marrow Bone Creek S 43° 07' W approximately 409.7 feet to a point in the center line of said Marrow Bone Creek in line with the south side of Alexander Street; thence S 75° 25' W approximately 160 feet to the intersection of the south side of Alexander Street with the east side of Adams Street; thence with the east side of Adams Street N 12° 15' W 30 feet to a corner on Adams Street; thence N 75° 25' E 132 feet to a stake; thence N 39° 37' E 51 feet to an iron pin; thence N 12° 15' W 204.3 feet to the beginning corner, containing 1.20 acres more or less, in accordance with plat of property of Mrs. Sara E. Adams, prepared August 1947 by the Piedmont Engineering Service, Greenville, S.C., recorded in R.M.C. Plat Book S, page 19, Greenville County
