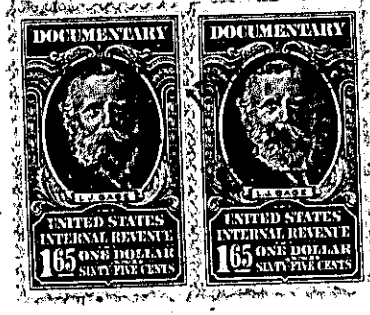

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by  
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Clarence Solesbee

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, known as Lot # 1 of the sub-division of the  
estate of J.M. McClure named by his last will, having the following  
metes and bounds and courses and distances.  
Beginning on a pine stump, A.D. Pruitte corner running thence; N. 44 W.  
3.00 chains to a stake in old road N. 1 1/2 W. 7.12 to a point in road  
thence; N. 12 W. 3.13 to a point in road, thence; North 2.30 to a point
