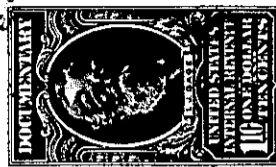

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, beginning at a stone at the Northeast corner of lands belonging to Morris and Wade Plumley, and at the Northwest corner of the Dennis M. Lockhart Estate, running North 34-50 East 1498 feet to a stone at the corner of Taylor-Colquit Company land; thence South 55-05 E. 1040 feet to a point in line of Taylor-Colquit Company; thence South 48 West 1612 feet to Morris and Wade Plumley line; thence North 48-16 West 685 feet to the beginning corner, being of all Lot No. 12 as shown on plat of Dennis M.
