I, O. Frank Thornton, Secretary of State of the State of South Carolina, hereby certify:

WHEREAS, Fifty freehold voters of the proposed town of CITY VIEW, did on the 27th day of October 1959, file with the Secretary of State a written petition signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That they were citizens and freehold electors of the proposed town.

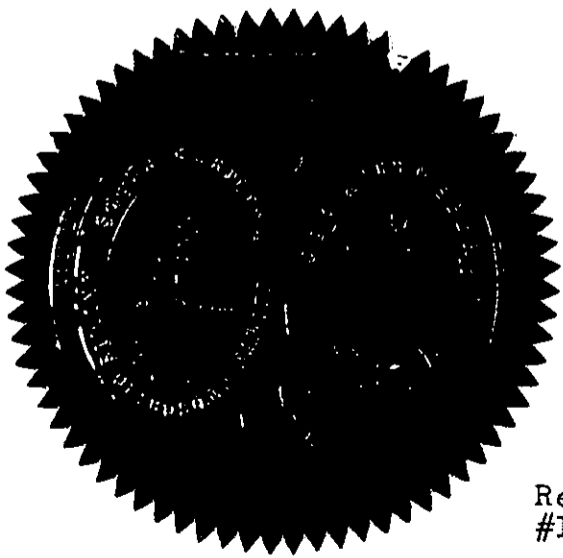
SECOND: The name of the proposed town to be CITY VIEW.

THIRD: The incorporate limits of the town to be as set forth in the petition.

FOURTH: That they desire to be incorporated.

AND WHEREAS, on the 8th day of January, 1960, the said ZIMMIE MASON, GEORGE LEDBETTER, LONNIE PRINCE, B. F. AIKEN, C. E. BLANKENSHIP, A. O. THOMAS, CLYDE SPRINGFIELD, J. O. SUTTON, R. J. JONES and F. A. NOBLETT, who were commissioned by me did file with the Secretary of State their return in writing, over their signatures, certifying the result of said election, with the managers return attached, in favor of corporation, the name of the town, and that C. CLYDE A. SPRINGFIELD was elected Mayor, and E. F. ASH, CLINTON H. CAMPBELL, WILLIAM B. DENTON, THOMAS L. JONES, JR., CLYDE C. LANDRETH, ZIMMIE EARL MASON, THOMAS R. PRIDMORE and LONNIE PRINCE, were elected Aldermen.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by Section 47-303, Code of Laws for South Carolina, 1952, as amended, do hereby issue to the Mayor and Aldermen elect this Certificate of Incorporation of the town of CITY VIEW, with the powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to the limitations prescribed by Title 47, Chapter 4, Code of Laws for South Carolina, 1952, as amended.
