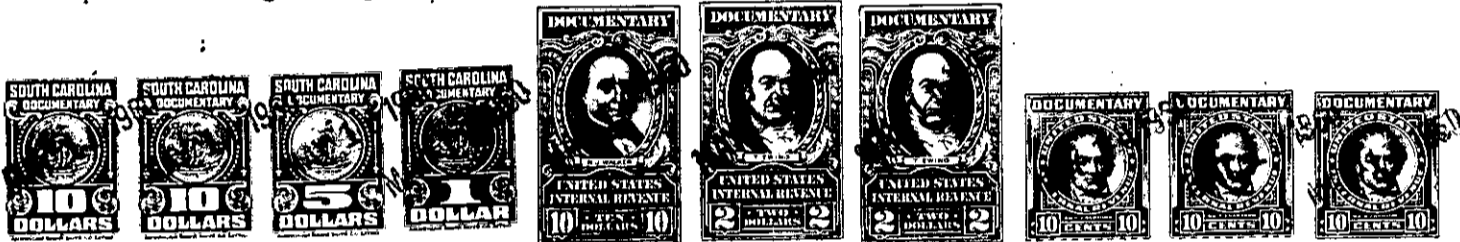
That I, J. Cleo Roper in the State aforesaid,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 11 in a subdivision known as Ila Court, a plat of said subdivision being recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB at page 101, and according to a recent survey by T. C. Adams, Engineer, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
