I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Bessie Q. Wood, in her own right and as Administratrix of the
Estate of I. M. Wood, deceased, Plaintiff

on or about the 7th day of July in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and Thirty Seven exhibited her
complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against T. J. Wood,
Pearl W. James, et al, Defendants

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 20th day of February 19 60
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,
Greenville County, South Carolina, a body
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to politic, its successors and assigns
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Preesents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Greenville County, South Carolina, a body politic, its
successors and assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being
in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
shown as three new streets named Lakeland Drive, Woodfield Drive and
Welcome Avenue on a plat of Lake View Heights, property of the Bessie
Q. Wood and I. M. Wood Estates, said plat being prepared by H. S.
Brockman and John A. Simmons on November 2, 1959, the same being
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "RR"
at page 19, and said streets being a minimum of 50 feet wide and having
the courses and distances as shown on said plat. The purpose of this
deed is to convey said streets to the County of Greenville for use as
public roads and streets.

This deed is made pursuant to Order of the Court and is without any
monetary consideration and, for that reason, it is not necessary to
place any revenue stamps hereon.
