

of the lot above described shall have the right to build upon any portion of such wall which might be added by Rush upon payment of one-half of the cost of such addition; further, subject to the rights and reservations contained in the conveyance of W. A. Wallace to J. H. Rush recorded in Vol. 57, at page 458, whereby said Wallace conveyed to J. H. Rush, his heirs and assigns, one-half of the south wall and one-half of the ground upon which the wall stands, and on which there were certain reservations in regard to tying to said wall; being the same property conveyed to me and others by two deeds being respectively recorded in Deed Book 569, at page 479 and Deed Book 549, at page 349.
