Know All Men by These Presents:

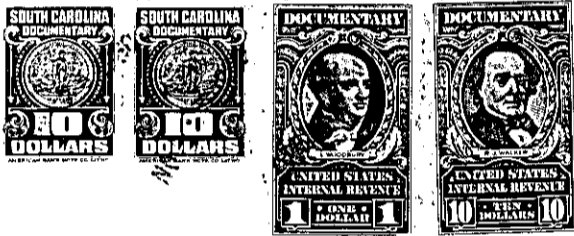
That I, Eugene Rackley in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Nine Thousand Nine Hundred (\$9,900)----- DOLLARS,
