a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen Hundred Ninety-Five and no/100 (\$1,395.00) dollars, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Edgar W. Teasley, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being on the southerly side of Fleetwood Drive, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 56 on the plat of Magnolia Acres as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book GG, page 133, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southerly side of Fleetwood Drive at a point 147 feet west of the southerly corner of the intersection of Fleetwood Drive and Cool Brook Drive, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots 55 and 56, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots S 1-48 E 200.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S 68-50 W 109.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N 37-38 W 59 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 56 and 57; thence along the joint line of said Lots N 18-57 E 213.4 feet to an iron pin on the southerly side of Fleetwood Drive; thence along the southerly side of Fleetwood Drive on a curve, the chord of which is S 81-50 E 63 feet to the point of beginning.
